DESCRIPTION

SikaBlock[®] LAB 850 is a dark blue tooling board with high impact resistance for foundry patterns and core boxes.

PRODUCT BENEFITS

- High impact resistance
- Easy machining
- Very good abrasion resistance
- Very good surface aspect after machining

AREAS OF APPLICATION

SikaBlock® LAB 850 is designed for foundry patterns and core boxes for cold box process. It is as well suited for diverse molds and tools. This product is suitable for experienced professional users only. The boards must be tested for the specific application in each case, e.g. type of sand molding process, binder, amine catalyst, etc.

METHOD OF APPLICATION

Product preparation

Before SikaBlock[®] LAB 850 boards can be processed (machined) they must be conditioned to 18 °C – 25 °C.

If the boards need to be bonded, make sure that the surfaces are clean, dry and free of grease or oil. For cleaning Sika[®] Cleaner G+M or another suitable cleaner or solvent can be used.

For bonding SikaBlock[®] LAB 850 boards together use SikaBiresin[®] B180. Further details on the adhesives can be found in the respective Product Data Sheet.

Application

SikaBlock[®] LAB 850 can be easily machined by milling, drilling, sawing or modified manually. It is recommended to use high performance tools to machine these boards.

For milling parameters check information from cutting tool manufacturers or get the General Guideline "Milling parameters for SikaBlock[®]" for more general information.

STORAGE CONDITIONS

The board needs to be stored flat over the entire surface in dry conditions.

Many models and tools are made of bonded boards, either with identical or other materials. Storage at low and elevated temperature can lead to high stresses due to the different expansion coefficients. To prevent this, it is necessary to store the models and tools at a temperature range between 15 °C and 30 °C.
