DESCRIPTION

Sikaflex[®]-250 DP-2 + SikaBooster[®] P-50 is an accelerated, high modulus polyurethane adhesive system for direct glazing applications. With the use of SikaBooster[®] P-50, it cures largely independently of atmospheric moisutre.

The product is developed for assembly bonding in automotive industry.

Sikaflex[®]-250 DP-2 + SikaBooster[®] P-50 is manufactured in accordance with ISO 9001 / 14001 quality assurance system.

AREAS OF APPLICATION

Sikaflex[®]-250 DP-2 + SikaBooster[®] P-50 is suitable for automated and manual direct glazing as well as permanent elastic bonding of components in the automotive industry.

Sikaflex®-250 DP-2 + SikaBooster® P-50 bonds well to numerous substrates. Common substrates are pre-treated UV protected glass, pre-treated cermic frit, e-coat and painted surfaces.

This product is suitable for experienced professional users only. Tests with actual substrates and conditions have to be performed ensuring adhesion and material compatibility.

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CURE MECHANISM

Sikaflex[®]-250 DP-2 + SikaBooster[®] P-50 cures by reaction with moisture provided by Sika-Booster[®] P-50 and largely independent from atmospheric moisture. For typical strength build up data with 2.0 vol% SikaBooster[®] P-50 see table below.

CHEMICAL RESISTANCE

Sikaflex[®]-250 DP-2 + SikaBooster[®] P-50 is generally resistant to fresh water, seawater, diluted acids and diluted caustic solutions; temporarily resistant to fuels, ethanol, mineral oils, vegetable and animal fats and oils; not resistant to organic acids, glycolic alcohol, concentrated mineral acids and caustic solutions or solvents.

METHOD OF APPLICATION

Surface preparation

Surfaces must be clean, dry and free from grease, oil, dust and contaminants.

Surface treatment depends on the specific nature of the substrates and is crucial for a long lasting bond.

All pre-treatment steps must be confirmed by preliminary tests on original substrates considering specific conditions in the assembly process.

Application

Sikaflex®-250 DP-2 + SikaBooster® P-50 needs to be processed with an adequate dispensing system. The mixer type must be respected (see table Typical Product Data).

Deviation from described mixing-ratio has to be tested, to ensure product properties.

Sikaflex[®]-250 DP-2 + SikaBooster[®] P-50 shall be applied between 15 °C and 35 °C (ambient) but changes in reactivity and application properties have to be considered. The temperature for substrate needs to be at least 3 °C above the dew point. To ensure a uniform thickness of the bondline it is recommended to apply the adhesive in form of a triangular bead (see figure 1).



Figure 1: Recommended bead configuration

The open and curing time is significantly shorter in hot and humid climate. The parts must always be joined within the open time. For advice on selecting and setting up a suitable pump system, contact the System Engineering Department of Sika Industry.

For transparent substrates, bond faces must be fully UV protected by suitable design or means.

Tooling and finishing

Sikaflex[®]-250 DP-2 + SikaBooster[®] P-50 is not suitable for tooling. If tooling is required, use Sikaflex[®]-250 DP-2 without SikaBooster[®].

Removal

Uncured Sikaflex[®]-250 DP-2 + SikaBooster[®] P-50 may be removed from tools and equipment with Sika[®] Remover-208 or another suitable solvent. Once cured, the material can only be removed mechanically.

Hands and exposed skin have to be washed immediately using hand wipes such as Sika® Cleaner-350H or a suitable industrial hand cleaner and water.

Do not use solvents on skin.
