Sikaflex®-650 VG-1 + SikaBooster® P-50 is an accelerated, high modulus polyurethane adhesive system for direct glazing applications. With the use of SikaBooster® P-50, it cures largely independently of atmospheric moisutre.

Sikaflex®-650 VG-1 + SikaBooster® P-50 is based on Purform® technology and shows an ultra low residual monomeric diisocyanate content. A training of the staff with certification isn't required.

The product is developed for assembly bonding in automotive industry.

Sikaflex®-650 VG-1 + SikaBooster® P-50 is manufactured in accordance with ISO 9001 / 14001 quality assurance system.

Sikaflex®-650 VG-1 + SikaBooster® P-50 bonds well to numerous substrates. Common substrates are pre-treated UV protected glass, pre-treated cermic frit, e-coat and painted

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CURE MECHANISM

Sikaflex®-650 VG-1 + SikaBooster® P-50 cures by reaction with moisture provided by Sika-Booster® P-50 and largely independent from atmospheric moisture. For typical strength build up data with 2.0 vol% SikaBooster® P-50 see table below.

CHEMICAL RESISTANCE

Sikaflex®-650 VG-1 + SikaBooster® P-50 is generally resistant to fresh water, seawater, diluted acids and diluted caustic solutions; temporarily resistant to fuels, ethanol, mineral oils, vegetable and animal fats and oils; not resistant to organic acids, glycolic alcohol, concentrated mineral acids and caustic solutions or solvents.

METHOD OF APPLICATION

Surface preparation

Surfaces must be clean, dry and free from grease, oil, dust and contaminants.

Surface treatment depends on the specific nature of the substrates and is crucial for a long lasting bond.

All pre-treatment steps must be confirmed by preliminary tests on original substrates considering specific conditions in the assembly process.

Application

Sikaflex®-650 VG-1 + SikaBooster® P-50 needs to be processed with an adequate dispensing system. The mixer type must be respected (see table Typical Product Data).

Deviation from described mixing-ratio has to be tested, to ensure product properties.




Figure 1: Recommended bead configuration

Sikaflex®-650 VG-1 + SikaBooster® P-50 shall be applied between 15 °C and 35 °C (ambient) but changes in reactivity and application properties have to be considered. The temperature for substrate needs to be at least 3 °C above the dew point. To ensure a uniform thickness of the bondline it is recommended to apply the adhesive in form of a triangular bead (see figure 1).

The open and curing time is significantly shorter in hot and humid climate. The parts must always be joined within the open time. For advice on selecting and setting up a suitable pump system, contact the System Engin-

For transparent substrates, bond faces must be fully UV protected by suitable design or means.

Tooling and finishing

Sikaflex®-650 VG-1 + SikaBooster® P-50 is not suitable for tooling.

Removal

Uncured Sikaflex®-650 VG-1 + SikaBooster® P-50 may be removed from tools and equipment with Sika® Remover-208 or another suitable solvent. Once cured, the material can only be removed mechanically.

Hands and exposed skin have to be washed immediately using hand wipes such as Sika® Cleaner-350H or a suitable industrial hand cleaner and water

Do not use solvents on skin.
